For those needing lodging, we have reserved blocks of rooms for each show. Be sure to request the "SNOWMOBILE USA" special negotiated rate when making your reservations directly with the lodging facilities. See hotel listing on pages 3 and 5.

If you need electrical services, place your order **directly with the facility** using the **electrical service order forms that are available for each show on-line at www.snowmobileusa.com by clicking on the "For Displayers" link.** If you would like paper versions of the electric order forms, please call 1-800-746-8963 to request set(s) of these forms to be mailed to you.

If you need tables, chairs, carpeting, special equipment or other booth dressing accessories, send your completed order forms directly to Valley Expo Displays for the Milwaukee show and to Art Craft Display Inc. for the Novi show. **All these order forms are available on-line from www.snowmobileusa.com by clicking on the "For Displayers" link.** If you would like paper versions of the Valley Expo Displays and/or Art Craft Display Inc. order forms, please call 1-800-746-8963 to request set(s) of these forms to be mailed to you.

Do not wait until the last minute to order these services. Meet their deadlines for electric and/or booth dressings and you will save money and eliminate the hassles of waiting for service on opening day of the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Booth Materials

All booth decorations must comply with fire regulations and will be enforced at each show. Gasoline and propane tanks must be empty and a locking fuel cap must be installed or the tanks must have their filler caps secured with duct tape. Battery terminals must be disconnected and wrapped with insulated tape.

Liability

Exhibitors shall assume all responsibility for damages to exhibit area caused by their negligence and shall indemnify and exempt Suburban Collection Showplace, Wisconsin Exposition Center, and Leisure Features Inc. from all claims for damages caused by exhibitor.

Name Badges

Exhibitors shall wear their name badges at all times while on the show floor. If you are attending both shows, save your badge, as the same name badge will be used at each show. **Please SAVE the order form onto your computer and then TYPE directly onto it.**

Milwaukee, WI Name Badge Requests due Sept. 26th
Novi, MI Name Badge Requests due Oct. 16th



Each (10x10) booth receives four name badges. Multiple booths will be allocated extra badges per show based on the following listed below.

Trailer Town booths (per show) will receive 6 badges regardless of booth size.

One booth	=	4 badges
Two booths	=	6 badges
TRAILER TOWN	=	6 badges
Three booths	=	7 badges
Four booths	=	8 badges
Six booths	=	10 badges
Seven+ booths	=	15 total badges

If you need additional badges, they are available for \$5.00 each. Name Badges must be ordered two weeks prior to the needed show.

If you need badges for more than one show, please order all badges for all personnel at the same time. All badges will be picked up at the show office. If you are unable to distribute a badge to a prior to the show, this system will be used:

The worker must pay at the gate and ask the ticket seller for a "Worker's Verification Card." A cash refund will be made by bringing the ticket stub and signed worker's verification card to the show office.

All exhibitors shall carry

Comprehensive coverage including premises, operations and contractual liability coverage of at least \$1,000,000 for personal injury, liability and property damage. Proof of same shall be furnished if requested by LFI prior to opening day of each show.

All of the show facilities have required this of us, and now we are also requiring it of you as exhibitors. Most of you already carry this type of insurance and only need to notify your agent of the need for a rider to be added for off premises coverage extension.

Check to be sure with your agent for the proper endorsements as they vary with each company and/or policy.

Security

Professional 24-hour a day, security will be provided from 7:00 pm on Thursday through 7:00 pm on Sunday at the Milwaukee and Novi shows. Exhibitors may enter the show floor one hour prior to show opening on Saturday and Sunday to freshen-up their booths.

Please do not try to enter the show floor when the show is not in progress.

This rule is for the security of your display and equipment. Identification badges will be issued to displayers for free admission to the shows. All other entry is via paid admission during show hours through the ticket offices.

If you think that we're being too "hard-nosed" about security and passes remember, the security of your material, products and items in your booth during off-show hours is vital.

With over 1,200 different displayers, we cannot know every exhibitor. Please cooperate with us on the protection and security of your display.

These rules are for your own security & assurance.

SPECIAL ATTRACTIONS

MR. SNOW & KIDUSA GAME

Mr. Snow, the SNOWMOBILE USA show mascot, will greet youngsters and adults at the shows.

Displayers may participate free of charge in the "Where's Mr. Snow?" search by displaying a photo of Mr. Snow (provided by Leisure Features Inc.) in their booth. It's a great way to attract new customers to your booth at the show!



Once a child confirms a picture sighting, the displayer simply rewards the child with a sticker (provided at no charge by LFI).

RULES & REGULATIONS

Swap Meet

The Milwaukee, WI show will have a Swap Meet for private sellers only.



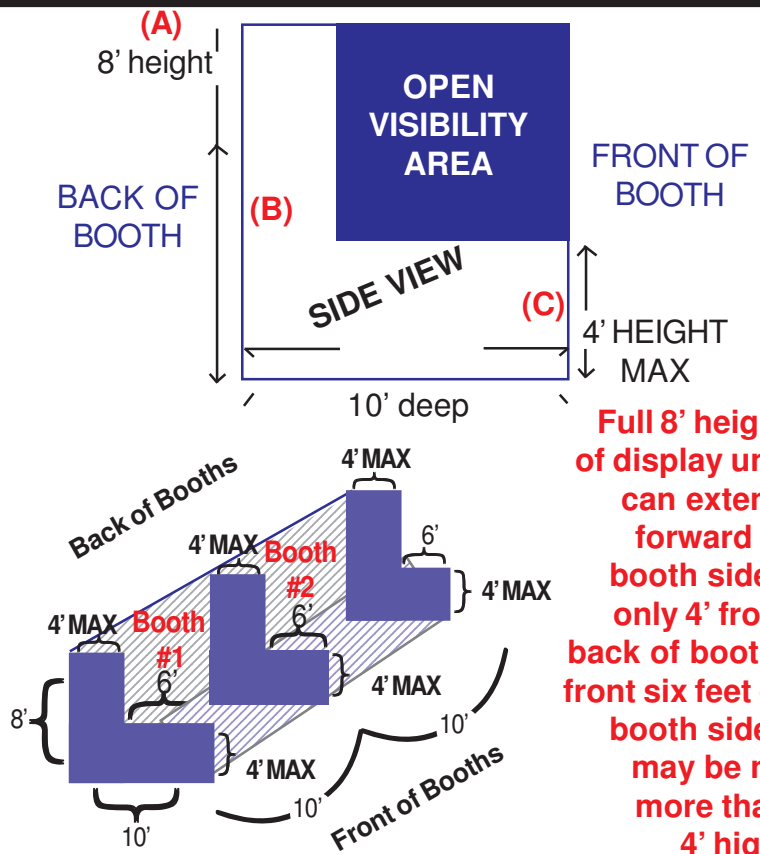
The Swap Meet is a place for used sleds, clothing, and parts to be sold. It also adds another event to the SNOWMOBILE USA show that brings in additional consumers.

Booth Guidelines & Restrictions

- Standard booth size** is 10' width and 10' depth. Exhibitors must fit within the space. Aisle space shall not be used for exhibits or product demonstrations.
- The booth structure, content or signage:**
 - (A) May NOT be more than eight (8) feet in height across the back unless approved by show management.
 - (B) May NOT be more than eight (8) feet in height in rear four (4) feet of booth sides.
 - (C) May NOT be more than four (4) feet in height in front six (6) feet of booth sides.
- No exhibitor may impede another exhibitor's ability** to conduct normal business, i.e., side walls that block the view of another exhibitor, loud or distracting noises and or presentations.

You can request an Application for a Permit/Certificate by calling the Department of Revenue at 608-266-2776. Or go online to www.revenue.wi.gov/forms/sales/s-012f.pdf for the Wisconsin Sales and Use Tax Return Form ST-12. Complete the ST-12 form and mail. **Sales Tax: 5.6%**

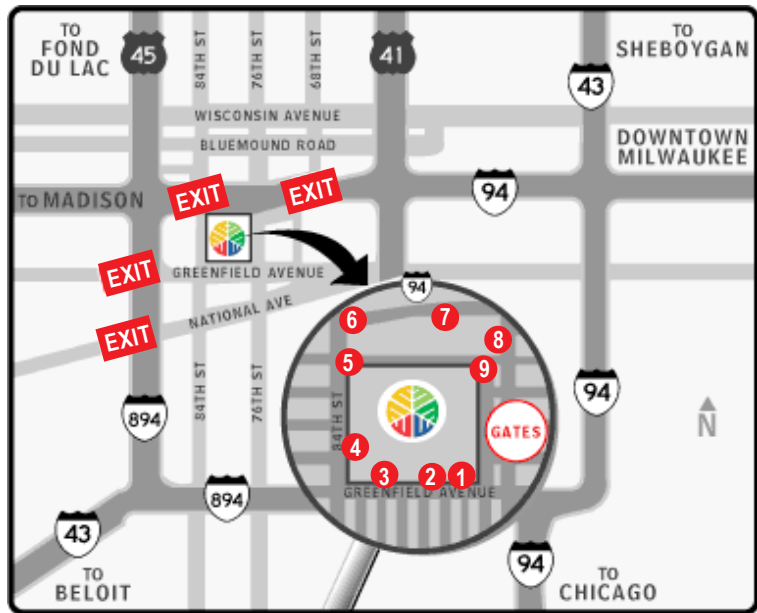
DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE MILWAUKEE, WI SHOW

GUIDELINES FOR ENTERING THE SHOW SITE

Displayer Entrance - Gate 1
Handicap Entrance - Gate 4
Regular Parking - Gates 1 & 5

Upon entering you will be directed to park along side of the show hall, follow the parking signs.

EXHIBITORS LOT from **Gate 1** will be conveniently located at the south east corner of the show building. This gravel lot is located directly behind the building.



PARKING PASSES



Parking Passes are available for the weekend allowing in and out admittance during the day. There is no charge for parking during set-up hours.

You may purchase a parking pass at the Wisconsin Exposition Center service counter on site before the show begins on Friday October 13th.

The Exhibitor Lot will be open for you to park, once you enter the park after paying at the gate.

DIRECTIONS

From the NORTH:
 Heading south on Highway 45, take the Greenfield Exit. Go left (east) on Greenfield Ave. past 84th Street. At first set of lights after 84th Street turn left into Wisconsin State Fair Park's main gate (Gate 1).

Heading south on Highway 43, take I-94 west to 84th Street exit. Turn left (south) on 84th Street. Wisconsin State Fair Park will be on your left.

From Chicago and other points SOUTH:
 Take I-94 north (toward downtown Milwaukee), and then take I-94 west (toward Madison). Take 84th Street exit. Turn left (south) onto 84th Street. Entrances to Wisconsin State Fair Park will be on your left.

From the SOUTHWEST:
 Take the I-894 bypass to the Greenfield Exit. Go right (east) on Greenfield Ave. past 84th Street. At first set of lights after 84th Street turn left into Wisconsin State Fair Park's main gate (Gate 1).

DISPLAYER PARKING

DIRECTIONS

From the **NORTH**:

Take US-131, US-27 or US-23 South to I-96 East to Exit 162. Turn right onto Novi Rd. and at the third stop light; turn right onto Grand River Avenue. Event Center is approximately 1 ¼ mile down on the right hand side.

From the **WEST**:

(A) I-94 to M-14 East to 275 North to I-96 West to Exit 162. Turn left onto Novi Rd. and at the third stop light; turn right onto Grand River Avenue. Event Center is approximately 1 ¼ mile down on the right hand side.

(B) I-96 East to Exit 162. Turn right on Novi Rd. and at the third stop light, turn right onto Grand River. Event Center is approximately 1 ¼ mile down on the right side.

From the **SOUTH**:

(A) I-94 East to M-14 East to I-275 North to I-96 West to Exit 162. Turn left onto Novi Rd. and at the third stop light; turn right onto Grand River Avenue. Event Center is approximately 1 ¼ mile down on the right.

(B) I-69 North to I-94 East to M-14 East to I-275 North to I-96 West to Exit 162. Turn left onto Novi Rd. At the third light; turn right onto Grand River Avenue. The Event Center is approximately 1 ¼ mile on the right.

(C) US-23 North to M-14 East to I-275 North to I-96 West to Exit 162. Turn left onto Novi Rd. and at the third stop light; turn right onto Grand River Avenue. Event Center is approximately 1 ¼ mile down on the right.

(D) I-75 North to I-275 North to I-96 West to Exit 162. Turn left onto Novi Rd. and at the third stop light; turn right onto Grand River Avenue. Event Center is approximately 1 ¼ mile down on the right hand side.

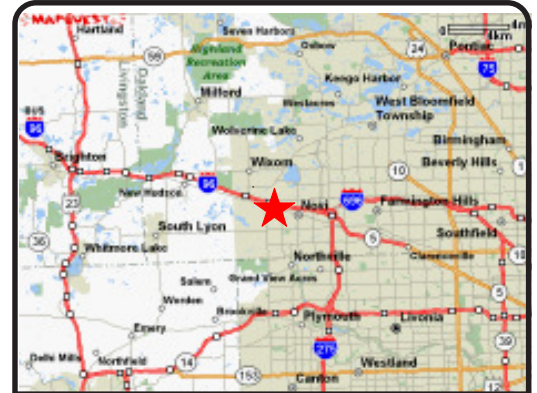
From the **EAST**:

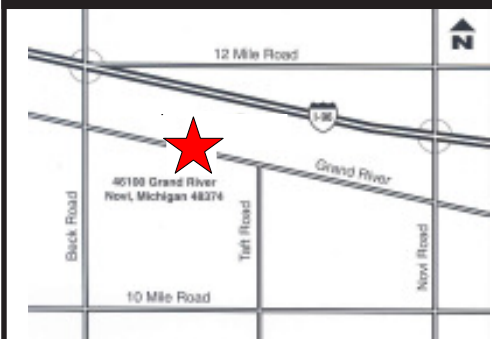
